They come to our programs through their love of soccer/football and end up learning important life lessons on conflict resolution, inclusion, health education and gender equality.

It was an absolute thrill and honor to have accepted two big awards for our work this year; the Beyond Sport Award for Health and Wellbeing plus the Peace and Sport award for best Nonprofit organization using sport for Peace and Development. When asked what we attribute our success to I replied we keep going, in Kreyol we like to say "Kenbe Fem" meaning stay strong. This work takes a huge commitment and dedication and we stay motivated because we know firsthand what an impact together, we are making for the kids and their future. PROGRAMS

GOALS uses soccer in Haiti to engage youth and their families in programs that emphasize education, health and the environment to improve their quality of life on a daily basis. Through leadership development and social change initiatives we are creating stronger, healthier communities in rural Haiti.



SOCCER

The love of soccer brings the kids to our programs. We provide a safe space and the coaches for daily soccer practice, mentoring, education, and nutritional support for approx. 400 kids in rural Haiti. 90% of our kids had not played sports before our programs.

EDUCATION

The opportunity to attend classes and learn is a source of immense pride for the kids and their families. The 'Leveling the Playing Field' literacy project teaches literacy and numeracy to kids that otherwise would be left behind. To date, 157 children and 20 adults have successfully completed the program, each achieving measurable progression in learning.

DREAM TEAM

Our Dream Team scholarship program provides tuition, uniforms and books for 25 high school students each year. For many families sending a child to school is the highest priority but is also an expensive choice that is prohibitive for their daily subsistence living.


